A meeting of the Gloucester Traffic Commission was held on Thursday, September 23rd, 2021, at 6:00pm in the First Floor Conference Room at City Hall.

The meeting was opened at 6:00pm by Chairman Robert B. Ryan. Other attending commission members were Mike Mulcahey, Michael Mitchell and Drew White .and others in attendance were Sam Parisi, Rose Parisi and Joelle Rose.

MINUTES

Approval of the July 29th, 2021, meeting minutes.

A MOTION was made by Mike Mulcahey and seconded by Michael Mitchell to approve the minutes as written. The motion unanimously passed.

Handicapped Parking / Disabled Veteran Requests and Deletions:

AMEND the GCO: Sec. 22-287. Disabled Veteran / Handicapped Parking. By DELETING: Knowlton Square, southerly side, 45 feet from a point beginning with its intersection with Washington Street in an easterly direction for 22 feet, one space.

Joelle Rose, the resident at 197 Washington Street informed the Commission members that she is planning to widen her driveway and asked if the Commission would consider moving the Handicapped space 10 to 15 feet to accommodate her plans.

The Board was also informed by Councilor LeBlance that the original requestor for the space passed and that the space was no longer needed.

As a result, a motion was made by Mike Mulcahey, and seconded by Michael Mitchell to remove the space. The motion unanimously passed.

Amend the GCO: Sec. 22-287. Disabled Veteran / Handicapped Parking: By DELETING: 15 Whittemore Street.

Both a family member and Councilor Malissa Cox informed the Commission that the space was no longer needed as the requestor had passed.

A motion was made by Mike Mulcahey and seconded by Michael Mitchell to approve the order. The motion carried unanimously.

**AMEND the GCO: Sec. 22-287. Disabled Veteran / Handicapped Parking. By ADDING
22 Hammond Street.**

Lola Lovett, the requestor, resides at 22 Hammond Street, and as a result of her medical issues has ask for a space to accommodate her needs at the-entrance to her walkway. Ms. Lovett provided her Handicapped Placard as required by the Commission.

After review of the circumstances, Drew White made a motion to approve the order, and it was seconded by Mike Mulcahey. The order passed unanimously.
