Item Two: Article IV Section II Anchorage Areas Discussion about the proposed language from Suzanne Egan centered around the fact that anchoring must be open to all on an equal basis. Ralph drafted proposed language to improve the section in the regulations and will discuss it with Suzanne Egan and report back to the committee.

Item One: Article VIII Public Waterways Traffic and Safety Section 1 (A) Prohibition of Lobstering in Regulated Areas

Jim gave some background on his involvement in establishing coordinates for the no lobstering in the Inner Harbor boundary while the committee waited for both Jay Gustafaro and Tony Gross. Cate Banks had asked the Harbormaster's office to notify Mr. Gustafaro of this agenda item but had no confirmation that he had been notified.

Since neither had arrived by the time the Item was to be discussed, Ralph moved that the committee make no changes to this section of the regulations. Cate Banks second and the motion passed.

Item Three: Prioritize any other Policies, Rules and Regulation issues that need to be discussed at future meetings The committee discussed bringing Article IV Section 5 back to the table for review, along with adding a specific timeframe for the Harbormaster Performance review to Article I Sec 10-3 (e) and including the management plan for the City Owned Commercial Marinas in the appropriate Article and section.
