First order of business was to look at the page that Phil Cusumano presented showing Section 5 G all on one page. All were in agreement that this works fine and is easy to read and understand.

Next we clarified that the decision to require a different length of bottom chain in Exposed area 2 is best for this area.

The committee resumed work on Section 6 Personal Moorings. Cate presented a draft proposal that reflected moving the existing paragraphs to new locations within the section for ease of understanding. The committee agreed that this worked better.

Jim will check once more with the City's legal department regarding the appeal to the State law about a difference in mooring fees for residents and non residents.

Jim also will provide a total of non resident mooring permittees to calculate how our income would change if the fee is changed.

Tony agreed to draft a separate section on "swapping" moorings. Cate will draft one about "temporary assignments"
