The minimum per foot monthly rental fee shall be calculated based on the maximum length vessel that the slip can accommodate.**
 - b. The following language be added to Article VII Section 5 subsection C following a public hearing. "If a person fails to respond and accept a slip by the end of 21 days their name will go to the bottom of the list"**
