### **Introduction of Licensing Board Members and Staff**

### **Public Hearings**

Continuation of a Public Hearing: Continued from May 12, 2015 for the Center Street Collective, LLC. The Applicant has applied for a New Seasonal All Alcohol Restaurant License for 65 Middle Street, Unit 1, Gloucester, MA. Description of Premise: 1,125 square feet, with one exit and one entrance; Seating: 28, Occupancy: 49.

First Public Hearing: Pardo Inc. d/b/a Jalapenos, 86 Main Street for an ABCC Alteration of Premise Application. The intent of the Applicant is to obtain the required approvals for outside dining areas during the Gloucester Block Parties. The enclosed area of 15; by 80' in front of Jalapenos will be roped off and will include the sidewalk and the street contiguous with the restaurant. There will be 14 tables each with 4 chars each; seating 56. There will also be an small outside bar without seating.

Continuation of Three Public Hearings: Continued from May 19, 2015 for an Alteration of Premise for the following three restaurants. The intent of each Applicant is to obtain the required approvals for outside dining areas during the Gloucester Block Parties:

- AM, Inc. d/b/a Dog Bar Restaurant- 65 Main Street
- Seniti Inc. d/b/a The Franklin Cape Ann-118 Main Street
- Topside Gill & Pub-50 Rogers Street

First Public Hearing: Alteration of Premise Application for Aqua Restaurant Corp. d/b/a Latitude 43, 25 Rogers Street. The Alteration include: Outdoor area with rope barriers with a capacity of 42 people which will be monitored by bouncers who will be relied upon to monitor the area and not let the outdoor capacity exceed 45.

Jody Huffcut – Cape Ann Rowing Club – for an event at 33 Commercial Street –Applicant has had Special One Day License in the past for this event. Event will be from noon to 10 AM – 3PM

to serve Malt/Beer within an approximately 25' x 60' gated area with police detail. Cape Ann Brewery will be serving beer to participants in the Blackburn Challenge, a rowing/paddling event around Cape Ann.

To sell wine at the Cape Ann Farmer's Market at Stage Fort Park, June 11, 2015 – October 8, 2015 - Daniel Clapp d/b/a 1634 Meadery, 3 Short Street, Ipswich MA.
