Variance requests regarding a proposed new-construction septic system design where the leach facility has been bifurcated into two locations and each section contains both primary and reserve area components.

Variances to the Gloucester Onsite Wastewater Regulations (Table 1):

- To reduced the distance between a coastal resource area to the reserve and the primary leaching facility, from 200 feet to 101.5 feet and 200-feet to 105.5 feet, respectively
- To reduce the distance between the primary leaching facility, with the Singulair treatment system, to a coastal resource area, from 200-feet to 103.6-feet.
