RE: Requesting City Council vote to reduce in-person early voting hours by 50% for the first week of early voting (10/24/22 -10/28/22) for the November 8, 2022 State Election in accordance with c. 92 of the Acts of 2022, sec. 14, subsection (b)(3)(ii)

Chapter 92 of the Acts of 2022, Sec. 14, subsection (b) (3)(ii) allows the City Council to vote to reduce the in-person early voting hours by 50% for a total of 17.50 hours. Therefore, I am requesting for the week of October 24, 2022 through October 28, 2022, the City Council consider and approve reducing the in-person early voting hours by 50%.

The proposed reduced hours are as follows:

Monday, October 24, 2022 – 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
Tuesday, October 25, 2022 – 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
Wednesday, October 26, 2022 – 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
Thursday, October 27, 2022 – 12:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Friday, October 28, 2022 – 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

This matter must be voted on by October 2, 2022.
