SUBJECT: Hybrid Meeting Timeline / Return to Kyrouz

Per the request of the Council President, I am writing to offer an updated timeline for the arrival and installation of the audio/visual equipment that will allow for the running of true hybrid meetings in both Kyrouz and the Council Chambers at City Hall in light of the recent fire at City Hall.

Based on the most current information from both ProAV as well as Joe Lucido, DPW Assistant Director of Operations:

- All equipment has been received by ProAV at their warehouse and is ready for installation.
- Cleaning and restoration operations in Kyrouz have begun with full scaffolding being delivered and assembled as of 5/19/2023, and continuing through the end of August.
- ProAV will be able to perform their installation and setup work alongside this operation.
- For the purposes of planning, no hybrid meeting should be anticipated for Kyrouz until early September to ensure that all cleaning operations will be completed, all scaffolding removed, and City staff fully trained on the new system.
- As a reminder, there are no locations currently set up for true hybrid meetings beyond the Harbormaster Conference Room, per my presentation on 10/25/2022.

Should timelines allow for a sooner start, or require a longer timeframe for the completion of the cleaning and restoration work, I will update you accordingly.
