2. Memorandum from Planning Director re: Repeal of Code of Ordinances Ch. 12 "Marshlands," Sec. 12-27 "Floodplain Management"
3. CC#2022-028 (Worthley): Amend GCO Ch. 5 "Building and Building Regulations" Article IV "Construction of City-Owned Buildings" by adding a new Sec. 5-62 (cont. from 5/1/23)
4. CC#2023-029 (O'Neil): Amend GCO Ch. 22 "Traffic and Motor Vehicles," Art. VI "Traffic Schedules," Sec. 22-270 "Parking prohibited at all times" and Sec. 22-291 "Tow-away zones" be amended by ADDING "Main Street, southerly side, "Police Parking Only" beginning at a point 80' from the intersection of Main Street and Duncan Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 120' to across from the intersection of Main Street and Elm Street"
