Updates for Board

ABCC Updates – As of Thursday, July 9th

- Magnolia Convenience Corp, 2 Raymond Street – Transfer of License - the applicant was required to provide an updated DOR Certificate of Good Standing. The packet was sent back to the ABCC with the required document.
- Eden Restaurant Corp – 3 Duncan Street – Change of Manager – application had been sent back due and the reason stated was the Form 43 was not included though it was included so Administrative Assistant contacted ABCC and application was mailed back to ABCC.

- Eastern Point Yacht Club – 125 Eastern Point Blvd – Change of Manager – The Form 43 was not approved due to the fact that “While there is no objection to the appointment of the individual applying to be the Manager the Corporate vote authorizing said application and appointment was issued by Corporate Officers that have not been approved by this Commission” (the ABCC).
- Espressos Italian Grille & Pub – 116 East Main Street – Change of Manager – the ABCC requires that all forms submitted to the ABCC are typed. The applicant had originally handwritten forms. The packet was sent back from the ABCC to the Licensing Board. The Applicant typed the forms and the packet was resubmitted. The packet was returned once again stating forms had to be typed. The Administrative Assistant contacted the ABCC and hopefully this will be the last time the typed paperwork is reviewed.
- The Seasonal License Report was sent to the ABCC a few months ago. During the process, the Licensees had commented about errors on their Form 43s. The ABCC explained to the Administrative Assistant that any edits should be done by using red ink on a copy of the Form 43. The Administrative Assistant was contacted today by the ABCC to learn that the LLA must submit a new Form 43 for the edits as well as the copy with the edits done in red ink.
