The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. The Council President announced that the meeting is recorded by audio in accordance with state Open Meeting Law.

For Council Vote

- 1. To revoke the FY17 School Department Budget by Roll Call Vote pursuant to the City Council Rules of Procedure as amended 8/12/15 under Rule 15: Procedures for voting the annual city budget, subsection 4**

Council President Ciolino stated that under the Council's Rules of Procedure amended August 2015, Rule 15: Procedures for voting the annual city budget, subsection 4, the City Council should have voted the School Department bottom line budget by roll call Tuesday evening, June 14, 2016. Because of this oversight, the Council must now revoke the FY17 School Department Budget within 45 days after the receipt of the budget under City Charter, Section 6-2(b).

Councilor LeBlanc disclosed under MGL c. 268A that his wife works for the School Department but this would not affect his vote.

Council President Ciolino called Kenny Costa, City Auditor to read the motion, upon the Interim City Clerk, Joanne Senos to call the Council Roll which resulted in the following vote:

MOTION: On a motion by Councilor Memhard, seconded by Councilor Cox, the City Council voted BY ROLL CALL 8 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 (Orlando) absent, to approve the FY17 SCHOOL DEPARTMENT budget in the amount of \$40,169,057.

A motion was made, seconded and voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 5:32 p.m.
