Below is a list of known COVID-19 symptoms for which caregivers should monitor their children, and staff should monitor themselves:^{[1] [2]}

Fever (100.4 Fahrenheit or higher), chills or shaking chills

Cough *(not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)*

Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath

New loss of taste or smell

Sore throat

Headache *when in combination with other symptoms*

Muscle aches or body aches

Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea

Fatigue *when in combination with other symptoms*

Congestion or runny nose *when in combination with other symptoms (not due to other known cause, such as allergies)*

"COVID Toes" *red or purple lesions on toes or hands*
