Consistent with chapter 107 of the Acts of 2022, the Gloucester City Council, at a remote meeting held on **April 11, 2023** at 6:00 p.m. by remote participation, voted to approve the following:

IN CITY COUNCIL:

MOTION: On a motion by Councilor Nolan, seconded by Councilor O'Hara, the City Council voted by ROLL CALL 7 in favor, 2 (O'Hara, O'Neil) opposed, to AMEND Ch. 10 "Waterways Administration," Article IV. Moorings, Public Landings and City-Owned Commercial Marinas, Sec. 10-52 "Use of public landings" subsection (e) by INSERTING "No person shall use or consume alcoholic beverages or cannabis products on any public landing;" amend subsection (h) by INSERTING "Fees. The annual fee for the seasonal tie-up of dinghies, tenders or other auxiliary vessels, less than 12 feet in length, shall be \$400.00; storage of kayaks and paddle boards as designated areas of public landings shall be \$100.00;" INSERT NEW subsection (i) "Solomon Jacobs landing will have a \$5.00 per hour user fee."
