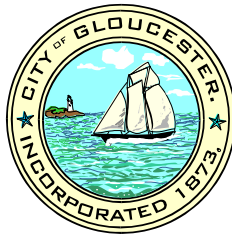

Reason(s) for Addendum: This addendum is being issued to respond to the questions asked via email and to extend the opening to **Wednesday, June 28, 2023 @ 11:00 AM**

Question #1	Why is there mention of benthic sampling in the "Years of Related Experience"? There is no benthic sampling in the requirements of the RFP. It simply involves collecting water samples 4 times per year.
Response	Page 8, #4: Change the last sentence to, "The sample report should represent a toxicity test report, or a project requiring equivalent water quality sampling and analyses." Page 9: Related Experience - Remove "experience in biological monitoring and, more specifically, benthic analysis in New England coastal waters" and Replace it with "experience in biological monitoring in New England coastal waters."
Question #2	In addition the turnaround time seems to be restrictive. Can you extend the time period when the proposals are due in?
